

<p><b>REARLIGHT WITH A SOFTBOX</b></p>   <p>With this setup, your subject's hair and shoulders are lit from behind, creating a subtle rim light effect. The softbox provides a soft, directional light from the front, creating a gentle shadow on the side of the face.</p>	<p><b>REARLIGHT THROUGH A SPOLLY</b></p>   <p>This setup creates a dramatic rim light effect on the hair and shoulders. The spolly (a circular light modifier) creates a soft, circular glow around the subject's head, while the front light provides a soft, directional illumination.</p>	<p><b>REARLIGHT WITH A HONEYCOMB</b></p>   <p>The honeycomb grid creates a very sharp and defined rim light on the hair and shoulders.
