Step 1

Step 2

Step 3

Step 4

Determine the literary objective of the book. Under the second heading of your outline, write notes about the message the author wanted to portray when writing the book. For example, the author may have used foreshadowing in order to provide you with insight on how the book would end.

Step 5

Take notes on the characters within the story. When you write the outline and the book analysis paper, you have to explain the qualities of the main characters within the book. For example, the main character of the book may have a bold personality, whereas the friend of the main character may be shy and timid.
