- `ls -al`: Lists files and directories with detailed information like permissions, size, owner, etc.
- `cd directoryname`: Changes the directory
- `cd ..`: Moves one level up
- `pwd`: Displays the present working directory
- `cat > filename`: Creates a new file
- `cat filename`: Displays the file content
- `cat file1 file2 > file3`: Joins two files (file1 and file2) and stores the output in a new file (file3)
- `touch filename`: Creates or modifies a file
- `rm filename`: Deletes a file
- `cp source destination`: Copies files from the source path to the destination path
- `mv source destination`: Moves files from the source path to the destination path
- `find / -name filename`: Finds a file or a directory by its name starting from root
- `file filename`: Determines the file type
- `less filename`: Views the file content page by page
- `head filename`: Views the first ten lines of a file
- `tail filename`: Views the last ten lines of a file
- `lsdf`: Shows which files are opened by which process.
- `du -h --max-depth=1`: Shows the size of each directory. Use `--max-depth=1` to limit the output to the current directory and its immediate children.
- `fdisk`: Disk partition manipulation command.
