<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prior to entering the First World War in April 1917, the United States scored away from involving itself in European affairs since Washington's Farewell Address that he delivered in 1796. • President Washington's sentiments were echoed by President Monroe in what became known as the Monroe Doctrine: "It is impossible that the allied powers should extend their political system to any portion of either continent without endangering our peace and happiness;... It is equally impossible, therefore, that we should behold such interposition in any form with indifference... It is not the least policy of the United States to leave the parties to themselves, to hope that other powers will pursue the same course." • President Cleveland exhibited America's intentions of maintaining its 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After gaining its independence from Great Britain, the newly created America expanded rapidly throughout the 19th century. With the purchase of the Louisiana territory from Napoleon in 1803, the nation's territorial expansion in that the landmass was two-thirds of the present United States. For President Jefferson, the territory added to America's economic development. By obtaining this huge landmass, farmers were able to transport their goods without paying a tax to a foreign power and were able to distribute their goods without delay. • Defeating Mexico in the Mexican-American War (1846-1848) and the subsequent terms within the Treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo enabled America to secure its southernmost, recently annexed and non-approved Texas (annexed into the Union as a slave state in 1845). The Mexican Cession became the following modern-day states: California, New Mexico, and parts of Utah, Nevada, and Colorado. America was fulfilling 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • During the antebellum period, the United States had two distinct regions in which the North was predominantly industrial, and the South relied heavily on slave labor to tend the plantations. These two ready distinct economies played a critical role in the outcome of the Civil War. Textile and military-based industrial factories were found in northern cities such as New York, Boston, Philadelphia, Chicago, and St. Louis. (Note: the northern coasts also had small farms and the midwestern farms supplied the north with grain and dairy goods and products.) These urban centers aided in the Union (Northern) victory over the South. The North had extensive railroad and canal transportation systems. The South, however, did not possess such facilities to support the war effort. During the Reconstruction era, the South underwent a major change in its economic development. Railroads, ports, roads, and communication systems were constructed. By the late 19th century, and as argued in Frederick Jackson Turner's Book of 1891, there was no available territory (there) that was unclaimed.
